The Scotch Malt Whisky Society is for people who enjoy fine Scotch. It began as a group of friends who shared the price of a cask of fine malt whisky. But of course Scotch Malt is a truly international drink and as membership grew, the Society was officially founded in 1983. Membership is now over 24,000 with branches in the United Kingdom, the Netherlands, Switzerland, Germany, Austria, Italy, France, Japan, and North America.

The Scotch Malt Whisky Society now does much more than whisky tasting. The Society has its headquarters in one of the oldest commercial buildings in Scotland—the Vaults in Leith, Port of Edinburgh—and runs a Members' Room in London, located in the heart of the City, as well as four self-catering flats in Edinburgh that can be booked by members. It holds a variety of events at both Members' Rooms throughout the year, including Burns Suppers, members' dinners, musical performances, and, naturally, whisky



tastings. The very finest whiskies are made available to members to buy by mail order and online, bottled direct from the cask in the peak of condition.

The Society is obviously a very different business than it was in those early days when the group of friends shared a wee dram. Similarly its financial management requirements have moved on considerably. The Society's existing accounting system didn't have the breadth to manage the full range of booking, subscription and membership services, retail operations, and events management now maintained by the Society.
